PROACTIVE PATROL EFFORTS:

1. Permit Compliance Check—Massage Spa
 - January 17th: Detectives, CORE and TNET collaborated for a compliance check at the Golden Spa located at 638 Wolfe Ave., Suite #2, after receiving multiple complaints alleging sexual activity was taking place at the business. After several weeks of investigation, a female was arrested for prostitution.
2. CORE officers facilitated community outreach to a business located downtown that had been experiencing recent thefts. Another business on N. Golden State was contacted for outreach regarding issues with transients.

CORE contacted a dental office that had been victim to a burglary multiple times since during the past few months. CPTED tactics were discussed to help prevent future break-ins.
